This is an outstanding story! One of the best children's missions story I have read. It's a keeper. After using it, I plan to file it and use again in a few years. It is adaptable to use as a drama with a storyteller for your children.

Download from the internet this (4) page story w/ (6) pictures drawn by a Nepali artist; pictures can be enlarged and colored to show as you tell the story.

Use this story as part of a unit about missionary work in Nepal. Do not try to finish it in one setting. Divide it in sections that can be read/discussed over several weeks. Supplement the lesson with prayer activities for the work in Nepal. VOM's PRAY TODAY app has prayer requests for Nepal from which you can choose those that are suitable for children. I like the fact that the prayer requests are up-to-date.

You are allowed to make one copy of the story to read/tell your children. The story counts as one book read for your awards requirement.

Develop a 20-30 minute lesson: EXAMPLE: "The Blue Blanket" p.48-51

continued: [INTRO] locate the continent Asia (map/globe) locate Vietnam discuss the word "refugee" use an actual "blue blanket" as you [STORY] read/tell the story w/ expression; practice reading have the children come close and view the drawing visual on p 48; have them identify what is going on (the people walking in front of their house in a distance); discuss why; what Beth is doing; etc [APPLICATION] discuss how you would feel and react if you were in Beth's situation; what would it be like to be a refugee; discuss how ministering to refugees is missionary work (supply needs & share gospel) Some of the stories can be dramatized by your children. We dramatized "Men in White". This story would work well as a puppet show too. (stick puppets) With "The Pink and Green Church" story we turned the lights out and used flashlights to walk through the "jungle" to the church service. There were bats hanging behind the pastor. A powerful story! The stories are very short, but very well written. They will hold children's attention. They cover missionary work from all over the world. It includes famous missionaries as well as less famous missionaries. This will give our children a strong missionary foundation.
